From Higher Level Training Cycles, they can participate in the Erasmus program thus practicing in foreign companies across Europe. Students will practice in order to make the most of this experience. The number of students who have benefited from living abroad is our indicator to find out if the participation in the Erasmus+ program is a success.

It must be said that the increase in enrollment is a fact that not only benefits the whole school but also helps to increase the number of students who make higher education in our region. In addition, do not rule out that some of the students who have done internships abroad can make an information session for students in vocational education and training for Middle and High School to encourage them to try this experience.

Erasmus policy statement.

The school has decided that in the next coming years, all educational school stages should perform mobility projects. These are the following goals and priorities that have led us to apply the Charter & Erasmus:

1. Increase and improve the mobility of teachers and students.
2. Contribute to the learning of foreign languages by immersion.
3. Improve knowledge of other cultures and lifestyles through exchanges.
4. Carry out mobility of students in the coming years (2014-2020).
5. Increase opportunities for employment in the European Union.
6. Discover different internship programmes in Europe to improve our current experience with companies in our territory.
